For vendor doing business with local government

This questionnaire reflects changes made to the law by Chapter 176, Local Government Code, by a vendor

has a business relationship as defined by Section 176.002(a)(1) of the Local Government Code. A vendor meets requirements of Section 176.002(a)(1) of the Local Government Code.

By law this questionnaire must be filed with the local government if the vendor has a business relationship with the local government that requires the statement to be filed. See Section 176.002(a)(1) of the Local Government Code.

A vendor commits an offense if the vendor knowingly violates Section 176.006 of the Local Government Code. An offense under this section is a misdemeanor.
