

# CONFLICT OF INTEREST QUESTIONNAIRE

For vendor doing business with local government agency

This questionnaire reflects changes made to the law by H.B. 2061, effective September 1, 2009. This questionnaire is being filed in accordance with Chapter 176, Local Government Code, and a vendor who has a business relationship with a local government agency must file this questionnaire if the vendor meets requirements under Section 176.006(a).

By law this questionnaire must be filed with the records of the local government agency no later than the 7th business day after the date the vendor becomes aware of facts that require the statement to be filed. See Section 176.006(a).

A vendor commits an offense if the vendor knowingly violates this section. An offense under this section is a misdemeanor.
