Dear Watson Graduate:

The Watson ceremony will be held on Friday, May 24, 2024, at 7:00 pm at Chisholm Trail High School, Jared Hardy Fine Arts Center, located at 3100 NW College Dr., Fort Worth, TX 76179. You will need to report at 6:00 pm to the CTHS Band Hall.

Cap & Gown:

- Decorations added to the graduation cap must be limited to the top of the cap, lay flat, and must be one inch away from the edge.
- All messages should be positive, of gratitude only and follow FNAA (LOCAL).
- Images of colleges, trades, or military branches are allowable within the limitations stated above.
- Dedication to family, teachers, or friends is allowable within the limitations stated above.
- Only caps meeting the guidelines will be allowed at graduation commencement.
- Decorated caps may only be worn at commencement. Activities where regalia is worn prior to commencement must be worn with a non-decorated cap (class picture, elementary walks, individual/group senior pictures, etc.)
- Caps that do not meet the requirements above will be replaced by a cap provided by campus administration.

Be sure you have ordered your cap and gown from Jostens. Everyone participating in the Watson ceremony will be wearing a black cap and gown, 2024 gold tassel, and gold Watson stole. After graduation, if you would like to donate your cap and gown for future Watson students, there will be a place for them to be collected.

Appropriate Dress for Graduation: *If you show up not wearing the proper attire, you will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.*

Men: Shirt-White or light collar to coordinate with robe color
Tie-Coordinate with shirt and robe color
Slacks-Dark dress slacks: NO Jeans, NO shorts
Shoes-Dark dress shoes: NO athletic shoes

Ladies: Dress or dark-colored pants-Any color that blends with the robe color: NO long dresses, NO jeans, NO shorts
Shoes-Dark dress shoes -You will have to climb stairs and walk across the wooden stage. You should choose shoes that are quiet and easy to walk in. NO athletic shoes.
